

it plans to file an answer and counterclaim. However, the process of drafting an answer and counterclaim and having it reviewed and approved by the various Department of Justice and agency attorneys who need to review it cannot reasonably be completed by the existing due date of May 12, 1999. Defendant needs at least until May 27, 1999 to complete that process.

4. In a telephone conversation on May 6, 1999, counsel for Plaintiff agreed to the enlargement of time sought by this Motion.

WHEREFORE, Defendant moves that this Court enter an order providing that Defendant is given to and including May 27, 1999, 1999 to respond to the Complaint.
