The "Statement of Work" for Request for Proposals number DU100C000018560, entitled Technical Assistance Services to Support Budget Preparation and Execution Functions of the Office of Housing, states that the Office of Budget and Field Resources has created and maintains "voluminous credit subsidy files/programs to track cohorts of various lines of business." They also maintain the Federal Housing Administration Contract Tracking System (FHACTS) which is a computer accounting system that provides information on actual expenses by fund account and control over obligations and payments.
