ORDER

This matter comes before the Court on Plaintiff's motion pursuant to the Right to Financial Privacy Act of 1978, 12 U.S.C. § 3410, for an order preventing the government from obtaining access to the personal financial records of the Plaintiff. The Plaintiff's personal financial records are the subject of the Office of the Inspector General's July 7, 1998 subpoena. The Plaintiff's motion complies ^{with} all the requirements of 12 U.S.C. § 3410(a), which establishes how the motion should be filed and what the motion shall contain.
